## Peace, Love, and FSN



Every year, around the holidays, FSN's office space is transformed: garland is hung, stockings are stuffed, and toys overflow the bags filled for our families in need of holiday cheer. This year, FSN's extensive resource base and growing capacity prevented any vulnerable family from being denied a holiday application. Since early November, the FSN staff had worked diligently to ensure that our families' children received age-appropriate toys, as well as clothing and shoes that fit properly and comfortably.

For weeks, dozens of families left FSN with gifts not only for their child with special needs, but also for the siblings. FSN graciously handled the holiday rush, providing as many families as we could with enough toys and clothing to last the year. However, the day before we were scheduled to close for the holidays, FSN received an urgent call from one of our community partners, asking if FSN could service a family whose child had been in the hospital for three months. The mother of this particular family had spent the last months there caring for her son, the victim of a gunshot wound, and had no time to shop for gifts for him or her two other children. FSN agreed to sponsor the family without hesitation. Despite the short notice, FSN garnered phenomenal support from our community sponsors and helped the mother and children by bringing presents, gift cards, and holiday cheer directly to the hospital. With the help of our community, FSN was able to provide gifts for more than 200 children this year.

### Parent Mentor Services Performs at 100%

In the most recent review of FSN's Parent Mentor Services program, every client surveyed reported a positive experience with their parent mentor, giving the program a 100% success rate for November of 2016. When asked what the clients liked best about the program, many relayed that it was the emotional support provided by the parent mentors. Others stated that it was the education and information provided. One individual shared: "I was told I would get my baby back in 6 months; I got my baby back in 2 months." Encouraged by these results and a recent meeting with state officials, Maria Enriquez, the Parent Mentor Coordinator, envisions an expanded Parent Mentor Services program that could satiate the demand for mentors and eliminate the waiting list.
